## Scottish Building Standards Compliance Building (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2010 Section 6: Energy (Domestic)

*The course consists of 1 day training and requires the use of a laptop computer, this will be provided. Basic experience of Windows would be useful. The training is aimed at those wishing to conduct assessments for building warrants of proposed housing for the purpose of demonstrating compliance with Section 6 (Energy) of the 2009 technical handbooks.*

Aimed at building standards officers, construction and housing professionals, this course will equip candidates with the necessary knowledge and practical experience to successfully complete an assessment of compliance with Section 6: Energy of the Building (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2010 as introduced on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010.

Alongside the SAP 2009 calculation route the course also covers the nominal dwelling compliance route and additional items which are mandatory for overall compliance with Section 6. The rules on dealing with conservatories and extensions are also included. SAP 2009 contains some significant changes over the SAP 2005 methodology.

After successful completion of the course, candidates will be able to provide an assessment of a domestic dwelling from plan drawings using approved computer modelling software (NHER Plan Assessor).
