Please see separate entry form for Primary school riders (available on the day only)

### Age categories are based on the year of birth

**Juvenile riders** - year of 13th and of 14th birthday

**Youth riders** - year of 15th and of 16th birthday

**Junior riders** - year of 17th and of 18th birthday

**Masters** - from year of 30th birthday

**Veterans** - from year for 40th birthday

**Grand-Vet** - from year of 50th birthday

**Sport** - any rider from year of 19th birthday (no upper age limit) except Expert or Elite licence holders

**Expert/Elite** - riders from year of 19th birthday (no upper age limit) who hold an Expert or Elite licence

*Note - non-licence holders are not permitted to ride in the Expert/Elite race*

**Open** 2 laps

The Open Race is aimed as a stepping stone from Beginners to age/ability category races. The race is for riders aged 16 and upwards, and will be held on the full race lap.

Each round is a one-off race - there are no series points for the Open category, although there will be prizes

**Beginner** 1 lap

Novice event aimed at riders who have never raced, and want the opportunity to have a go on the full race course. Each round is a one-off race - there are no series points. Open to all riders from 12 years old upwards

**Please make sure you circle the round(s) and categories entered and put the total payment in the appropriate box.**

**Please sign the rider declaration**

**U-18 riders must have signed parental consent**

### Cancelling an entry

If you have entered in advance but cannot ride, you may withdraw your entry by 5 pm on the Friday before the race, your entry fee may be transferred to the next event.

Riders who enter all 7 rounds in advance but cannot make one of the rounds will not be eligible for a refund.
