



KILMARNOCK (Barassie) GOLF CLUB

Information for visitors – Year 2010

COURSE

Kilmarnock (Barassie) Golf Club has 27 holes available for play by visitors.

Barassie Links – 18 holes - 6484 yards – S.S.S. = 72

Hillhouse Course – 9 holes - 2756 yards - S.S.S. = 34

Visitors are normally welcome to play the course on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. A limited number of tee times are available on Wednesday Saturday and Sunday.

Bookings for play should be made with the Club Secretary who will arrange and allocate Starting Times, which must be strictly adhered to.

The first Starting Time for Visitors in the morning is 9.00 am and in the afternoon 1.30 pm.

Visitors are required to play from the Yellow Tee Markers at all times.

Final numbers in the party must be confirmed to the Secretary at least 7 days before the visit. Failure to do this may result in Green Fees being charged for the original number quoted.

All visitors should “check-in” at the Professional’s Shop before commencing play.

Green fees – Monday to Friday - £55 per round, £80 per day. Saturday & Sunday - £65 per round.

Caddies – Kilmarnock (Barassie) Golf Club does not provide caddies. However, visitors are welcome to make their own arrangements in this respect.

Pull trolleys – available for hire - £3 per round or per day.

Electric trolleys - available for hire - £8 per round: £13 per day.

Buggies - available for hire - £25 per round: £45 per day.

CLUBHOUSE

A full Catering Service is available in the Clubhouse, with Bar Snacks being served in the Lounges. Luncheons, High Teas and Evening Meals are served in the Dining Room.

All Communications relating to Catering should be made to the Club Caterer, and the final number of Visitors must be confirmed at least 7 days before the visit. If numbers are reduced on the day of the visit, the full cost of meals will be charged for the final number confirmed previously.

Catering requirements, if any, should be indicated in advance of your visit whenever possible.

Visitors must settle all bills before leaving the Clubhouse. MasterCard, Visa Credit and Visa Debit cards are accepted.

OSSINGTON LOUNGE

Shirt with Collar or Roll Neck - Tailored Trousers or Shorts.
No Denim Clothing or Training Shoes allowed

CASUAL BAR

Shirt with Collar or Roll Neck - Tailored Trousers or Shorts
No Denim Clothing or Training Shoes allowed

DINING ROOM

Dress until 6.30pm
Shirt with Collar or Roll Neck - Tailored Trousers or Shorts
No Denim Clothing or Training Shoes allowed

Dress after 6.30pm
Tailored Jacket and Trousers - Shirt with Collar and Tie
(Casual dress is not permitted in the dining room after 6.30pm)

PORTLAND LOUNGE

Shirt with Collar or Roll Neck - Tailored Trousers or Shorts
No Denim Clothing or Training Shoes allowed

NO OUTDOOR CLOTHING, BAGS, HOLDALLS SHOULD BE TAKEN INTO ANY OF THE PUBLIC ROOMS

The above regulations apply to Visiting Parties,
Members and their Guests, including children of 11 years and over

Use of Mobile Telephones is not permitted in the public areas of the Clubhouse.

GOLF SHOES MUST NOT BE WORN IN THE PUBLIC AREAS OF THE CLUBHOUSE FROM 1st OCTOBER TO 1st APRIL

ON THE GOLF COURSE

Dress will be appropriate golfing wear at all times.

Denim clothing, collarless shirts, inappropriate trainers and tracksuits
are not acceptable at any time.

Shorts must be tailored; cycling shorts and football/rugby shorts are not acceptable.

Mobile Telephones may be used on the golf course only in an emergency.
