

Below is a sample of the cask strength malt whiskies on our list

ABERLOUR a'bunadh 12 Years Old 59.6%

a'bunadh is gaelic for the origin. No age statement but not less than 10 and no more than 15 years old. Sherry-Ageing with and emphasis on 2nd-fill dry oloroso with no chill filtration Finish of nugget, cherry brandy, ginger and faint smoke. Perfect for after dinner.

THE BALVENIE SINGLE BARREL 15 Years Old Cask Strength 50.4% vol.

Rich and complex, suggestive of years of careful ageing, it has a honeyed maltiness with vanilla oak flavours, and hints of spicy peat notes. It has a long and complex finish with a touch of liquorice.

BENROMACH 18 Years Old Cask Strength 59.7% vol.

Big, smooth body with barley sugar and toasted nuts on the palate developing into a finish with hints of apricot and garden mint

BOWMORE Cask Strength 56% vol.

No age statement but in mid-teens. Smooth medium bodied with a leafy, peaty and orange peel finish

CARDHU 25 Year Old Rare Malts Cask Strength 60.02% vol.

Has a richer marshmallow maltiness with suggestion of crystallized fruit and a hint of tangerine in the finish.

CLYNELISH 1989 Cask Strength 57.9% vol.

Clynelish is a single malt of great character. It embodies all the qualities of a northern Highlands' malt, quite assertively. A good after-dinner malt, popular amongst connoisseurs.

Convalmore 24 Year Old Rare Malts Cask Strength 59.4% vol.

Spring like freshness. Elegant with light vanilla notes and hint of peaches with firm finish.

GLEN Mhor 1979 Cask 66.3% vol.

Palate of liquorice, treacle toffee and Madeira which develops into a warm spicy finish

HIGHLAND PARK 1989 Cask Strength 60% vol.

Pale straw in colour with an earthy, spicy character. Hints of heather, fruit and new wood are also present.

LAPHROAIG 10 year old Cask Strength 57.3% vol.

Drier with a seaweedy, salty, sweet tar like palate. Wonderfully complex whisky with a medicinal, tar, phenol, peaty, earthy finish.

SPRINGBANK 12 Years Old Bourbon Cask 58.5% vol.

Smooth bodied, briny aroma, fruity palate and a salty finish.

TAMNAVULIN Cask Strength Distilled 1988 58.9% vol.

Tamnavulin from the gaelic means 'mill on the hill' Sweet, toffee on the nose with a powerful body, sweet drying to floral on palate with a dry and clean finish.
