

Below you will find a sample of the malt whiskies on our list

THE BALVENIE FOUNDERS RESERVE 10 Years Old 40% vol.

Full bodied honeyed sweetness, with light spicy notes and a hint of sherry fruitiness. Its finish is long with a pleasant lingering richness.

BENROMACH 18 Years Old 40 % vol.

Classic stylish speyside malt, ripe gold in colour with hint of vanilla, honey and fruit with a spicy finish

BENROMACH 22 Years Old Port Wood Finish 45 % vol.

Rich and complex with different fruit flavours and a hints of roasted malt. Deep amber in colour, smooth and rounded with a dry finish.

CARDHU 12 Years Old 40% vol.

Light and smooth with emphasis on multi sweetness and vanilla. Lingering, syrup sweetness with a round dryness, and a very slight hint of peat.

CRAIGELLACHIE Connoisseurs Choice Distilled 1987 40% vol.

The distillery, which was founded in 1891 produces a well-balanced whisky with a sweet vanilla-like nose and a smoky palate. The finish is warming.

GEORGE AND J G SMITH 15 Years Old GLENLIVET 40% vol.

This distillery has been called a benchmark for Speyside malts. Fruity sweet nose with a medium body and slightly smokey palate.

LONGMORN 12 Years Old 40% vol.

This is a whisky much appreciated by lovers of single malts. It is nutty and complex with a delightful, fragrant bouquet. A classic, post-prandial malt.

STRATHISLA 25 Years Old 40% vol.

Strathisla originally known as Milton, is the oldest distillery in Northern Scotland, situated on the outskirts of Keith. It is fragrant and sweet on the palate, with hints of lemon and a medium finish.

SPRINGBANK 15 Years Old

Described as the "Premier Grand Cru Class of Malts. Palate of restrained salt, coconut, passion fruit, nut and toffee.

PORT ELLEN Connoisseurs Choice Distilled 1982 40% vol.

Bright amber red colour with a pungent, smoke-accented nose. Big peppery, smokey long finish

ROSEBANK Connoisseurs Choice Distilled 1989 40% vol.

Situated near Falkirk on the banks of the Forth and Clyde canal, close to the River Carron. Slight underlying sweetness on the nose, with a floral palate and a clean finish.

GLENGOYNE 17 Years Old 40% vol.

The only unpeated malt in Scotland, comes from Glengoyne distillery in Killlearn. This award winning whisky has a firm body and a complex palate, with a beautiful long Sherry finish.

ISLE OF JURA Superstition 45 % vol.

Deep intense mahogany colour with complex aromas of spice, honey, pine and peats.

BRORA 1982 40% vol.

Bright gold in colour with an aromatic, dry, lightly peated nose. Developing into a al light finish
