

Below you will find a sample of the red wines on our list

Stimson Estate Merlot 2005, 12.5% vol.

Lush, pleasurable Merlot with traditional raspberry and cherry characters and a smooth finish

De Bortoli Vat 1 Petit Syrah, 2004 South Australia, 13.5% vol

Also known as Durif. Rich with an abundance of black cherry, there are vanillin overtones and firm integrated tannins giving excellent length and a lingering aftertaste.

Segu Reserve Carménère 2005/06 14% vol.

Well balanced blend of 91% Carménère and 9% Carignan with high concentration and suggestions of vanilla, fresh fruits, spices and cigar box backed by a pleasant final hint of chocolate. An excellent example of the rare Carménère grape only recently re-identified in Chile and well worth trying.

Chateau La Tours Seguy 1999 Cotes de Bourg 12.5% vol.

A fine petit chateau which consistently makes soft plummy wine from mainly merlot grapes.

Chateau Cissac 1996 Cru Grand Bourgeois Exceptionnel 12.5% vol .

Good balance with depth of fruit and softening tannins. Medium to full bodied with a long and positive finish perfect with red meat, game and cheese

Bechtheimer St. Laurent QbA Trocken 2005 13 % vol.

St Laurent is one of the oldest vines which almost became extinct, very difficult to grow and becoming fashionable again. Grown mainly in Austria with very limited production in Germany. Medium, fruity red very similar to the Pinot Noir and Spätburgunder.

Castell Cuvée C - QbA trocken 2002 12.5% vol

This hand picked selection of premier grapes produces a wine with a bramble and vanilla nose and roasted aroma which develops a warming fullness in the mouth. Ideal with game and meat dishes with full bodied sauce. A blend of 15% Spätburgunder, 40% Domina and 35% Dornfelder which has been aged in oak casks.

Dornfelder QbA trocken 2004, Hasensprung, 13 % vol.

Gold Medal winner 2004 Medium full bodied, quality wine, with long lasting finish. Excellent with beef, game or lamb. Worth trying.

Chateau Musar 2001 13.5% vol.

Scarlet in colour, it has a complex nose of cigar box spice, warm leather, baked fruits, ripe morello cherries and blackcurrants. The palate has intense flavours of red cherries, dark chocolate, olives, figs and velvet smooth tannins on the very long finish.

Marlborough, Hunter's Pinot Noir 2006 13.5% vol .

Very well balanced medium bodied wine with soft red and black fruits on the finish.

Klein Constantia Malbrook Cabernet Merlot 2005 14% vol.

Superb oak aged blend with a complex palate and a long finish.

Torres Reserve Gran Sangre de Toro 2002/03 13.5 % vol.

Full bodied, moreish wine with a rich palate. Garnacha and Cariñena grapes.
